Scholarship Deadline: October 21st

1. The value of the scholarship award will be \$2,000.
2. The applicant must be enrolled in an accredited university or college, and preferably pursuing a degree in a field relating to agriculture or natural resources.
3. The applicant must be entering their freshmen, sophomore, or junior year of college.
4. The applicant must have worked a summer for a Wyoming Weed & Pest District for at least one season, and the successful applicant must work for a Wyoming Weed & Pest District the summer following the award to be eligible to receive the award.
5. The applicant must be nominated for the scholarship by the district supervisor.
6. The application deadline for the scholarship will be October 21st, and the selection will be completed by November 30th.
7. The award will be distributed the following August pending a satisfactory job performance review that is completed by the district supervisor.

2016 Wyoming Weed & Pest Council Internship Scholarship

Description & Guidelines

1. The value of the scholarship award will be \$2,000.
2. The applicant must be enrolled in an accredited university or college, and pursuing a degree in a field relating to agriculture or natural resources.
3. The applicant must be entering their freshmen, sophomore, or junior year of college.
4. The applicant must have worked a summer for a Wyoming Weed & Pest district for at least one season (summer or winter).
5. The applicant must be nominated for the scholarship by the district supervisor.
6. The application deadline for the scholarship will be October 21st, and the selection will be completed by November 30th.
7. The successful applicant must work for a Wyoming Weed & Pest district the summer following the award to be eligible to receive the funds.
8. The funds will be distributed in August pending a satisfactory job performance review that is completed by the district supervisor.
9. The committee shall be composed of active members of the Wyoming Weed & Pest Council. A three member committee elected at large will serve three year rotating terms. There should not be more than one member on the committee from the same area. If there is a conflict of interest between a committee member and an applicant, the committee member shall excuse them self from the committee.
